Additional Highlights:

- SFP's tenth boundary-pushing **PIVOT Festival**, guest curated by composer/musician **Gabriel Kahane**, and featuring composer/violinist **Carla Kihlstedt**, the **Del Sol Quartet**, and **Sandbox Percussion**. Kahane, Kihlstedt, and the Del Sol Quartet will present Kihlstedt's *26 Little Deaths*, inspired by Edward Gorey's *The Gashlycrumb Tinies*. Sandbox Percussion will present Pulitzer Prize-nominated composer **Andy Akiho**'s evening-length *Seven Pillars*, a boldly genre-defying work for percussion quartet.
- Clarinetist **Anthony McGill** and the **Pacifica Quartet**'s program includes **Ben Shirley's** *High Sierra Sonata*, which was featured on their Grammy©-nominated *American Stories* album. Shirley has ties to the Bay Area, and his path from addiction and homelessness to becoming a composer and orchestrator was documented in the film *Skid Row Marathon*.
- Guitarist **Sharon Isbin** and sarod player **Amjad Ali Khan** pair up to present works from their acclaimed *Strings for Peace* album, exploring both Indian and Western classical music traditions.
- Violinist **Midori** returns to SFP with a program inspired by Spanish poet Federico García Lorca's *Casida of the Lament*, which includes new work by young New York-based composer **Che Buford**.
- Countertenor **Anthony Roth Costanzo** makes his Bay Area recital debut with a wide-ranging program that includes a tribute to Barbra Streisand.

San Francisco, CA, April 9, 2024 — **San Francisco Performances**, the city's premier presenter of intimate concerts and solo recitals, celebrates its 45th season in 2024-2025 with a wide variety of programs that span genres and eras. President **Melanie Smith** today made public details of SFP's upcoming schedule of 35 concerts, October 4, 2024 through May, 3 2025, and a complete list of artists and series may be found below. The 2024-25 season features SFP debuts by artists including **Randall Goosby**, **Anthony Roth Costanzo**, **Miloš**, **Fleur Barron**, **Sandbox Percussion**, the **Isidore String Quartet**, **Johan Dalene**, and **Thomas Dunford**, and West Coast premieres by composers **Che Buford** (for Midori), **Carla Kihlstedt** (for her PIVOT Festival performance), **Caroline Shaw and Gabriel Kahane** (for their collaborative performance), and **Sérgio Assad** (for the Assad Brothers).

"We are proud to be celebrating our 45th Season by continuing to do what we do best — presenting the finest artists in the world, and allowing them space to create personal and profound programs that inspire people," said Smith. "Since our founding in 1979, it's been our mission to center the artists and their work in our presentations, and it's gratifying to be able to continue to bring the best of the best to San Francisco."

Smith continued, "As is our tradition, our season features exceptional artists who are on the rise as well as artists audiences already know and love. Chamber music is always evolving, and we're proud to maintain our commitment to bringing innovative artists and programs to our stage."

The 2024-2025 season includes a **45th Season Favorites** series, featuring artists beloved by the SFP audience; a special fundraising gala performance by composer/pianist **Jake Heggie** and tenor **Nicholas Phan**; and the popular **Saturday Morning Series** with the **Alexander String Quartet** and **Dr. Robert Greenberg**. This will be the final season for the Alexander String Quartet, which will bid farewell to performing together at the end of their 2024-2025 season.

Smith added that additional programming for the 2024-2025 season will be announced during the summer. “We’re excited about what’s ahead,” she said. “Our 45th season will be a memorable one.”

San Francisco Performances’ PIVOT Festival is driven by a philosophy of innovation, creativity, and artistic excellence that pushes the boundaries of the traditional concert experience.

Composer/singer-songwriter **Gabriel Kahane** returns as guest curator once again for the tenth season of PIVOT. Kahane’s work exists at the intersection of art and social practice, and he is one of the most thoughtful — and thought-provoking — artists of his generation. He will perform opening night and host all three evenings of deliciously ingenious music brimming with thought, humor — both dark and light — and substance.

Composer, collaborator, violinist, singer, improviser, educator, and instigator **Carla Kihlstedt** explores complex worlds — the ocean, dreams, imaginary creatures, the machine age — through many different lenses. Kahane will lead her and the **Del Sol Quartet** in Kihlstedt’s *26 Little Deaths*, inspired by Edward Gorey’s *The Gashlycrumb Tinies*.

Grammy®-nominated ensemble **Sandbox Percussion** is dedicated to artistry in contemporary chamber music, captivating worldwide audiences with visually and aurally stunning performances. The ensemble will perform Pulitzer Prize-nominated composer Andy Akiho’s evening-length *Seven Pillars*, a boldly genre-defying work for percussion quartet.

This season will mark the final bow of the beloved Alexander String Quartet, which will say farewell to performing together at the triumphant close of 36 glorious years as SF Performances' Ensemble-in-Residence.
